



Are you age 55 and older and looking to re-enter the workforce but need to improve your job skills?

Comprehensive Community Action's Senior Community Service Employment Program may be able to help.



To qualify for the program, you must:

- Be 55 years of age or older, and a resident of Rhode Island.
- Have an annual family income must not be more than 125% of the established federal poverty income guidelines.
- Be eligible to work in the United States.



The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP), funded under Title V of the Older Americans Act, serves persons with low incomes who are 55 years old or over and have poor employment prospects.

The program has two goals: to provide useful community services and to foster individual economic self sufficiency through training and job placement in unsubsidized jobs. Services provided include:

- up to 20 hours a week of part-time employment in community service assignments, usually non-profits and faith-based organizations
- job training and related educational opportunities
- opportunities for placement into unsubsidized jobs
